### September

- 7 **Full day** schedule for all students in Grades 1–8.  
Grade K should arrive at 9:00, Grades 1–8 students should arrive no later than 8:10 a.m.  
Dismissal for Kindergarten is at 1:30 and for Grades 1–8 at 2:50.

Meeting for lunch parents and all volunteers at 9:30 a.m. in O'Mara Hall.

**\* There will be bus service for Grades 1–8. No Bus Service for Kindergarten until Monday, September 11. Parents of all students entering Kindergarten must register for bus on June 27 from 10:00 – 12:00. Anyone who has not taken the bus, but would like to start to take the bus must also register on June 27.**

- 8 **FULL DAY SCHEDULE FOR ALL STUDENTS IN GRADES K–8, 8:10 arrival time for K – 8.**  
Kindergarten dismissal at 2:40 p.m. and Grades 1–8 dismisses at 2:50 p.m. There will be bus service for Grades 1–8. No bus service for Kindergarten. All summer assignments due.
- 11 **Pre K 4 begins.** Classes begin at 8:30 a.m. Dismissal will be at 1 p.m. Students should bring their lunch.
- 11 **Early morning and after school begins for Grades K – 8.**
- 12 **After school begins for PreK4.**
- 12 **Pre K 3 begins with a Mommy and Child session.** The morning class will meet from 8:30–10 a.m. The afternoon class will meet from 12:00–1:30 p.m.
